- nationwide qualification standards set by competent federal ministries
- independent juries attached to chambers (of commerce, industry, crafts etc.) are in charge of examinations
- social partners are involved in the definition of basic features of the training profiles and their experts from companies work out details of training regulation
- qualification standards must be relevant for a whole segment of business activity, not just for one company
- initial vocational education and training in company and school during two to three and half years
- certificates for initial and further training are awarded after successfully passing examination procedures as defined in regulations.

There are nearly 480 further VET professions in Germany, 190 are nationwide qualification standards.
